

How can you participate in Philly Jeans for Justice?

(1) Pick a captain for your office team.

(2) Contact the Philadelphia Bar Foundation providing the name of your team captain and other basic office contact information. Download the simple participation forms on the website at https://www.philabarfoundation.org/events/2018-philly-jeans-justice.

(3) Pick a theme and day that works well for your office, through Friday, December 28th when this year's competition closes.

(4) **Recruit your colleagues to participate.** Send an email to your office. Post signs in the lobby and around your workspace.

(5) Individual participants donate online or in-person (through cash/check to the office team captain) and indicate their participation. Individual donations can be \$5 or \$5,000 – the most important thing is to join in the fun.

(6) Compete to see which office can raise the most. In every quarter of the year, the winning office will receive special recognition and the appreciation of those benefiting from your generosity.

(7) Have a blast on your day! Take photos and send them to the Philadelphia Bar Foundation. Post on social media and tag us to help spread awareness! Get others to donate as well.
